Construction at Automotive Education Facilities in Illinois

Profile on College of DuPage Facilities

The College of DuPage Automotive Service Technology program is located in a recently constructed (2009) Technical Education Center. The Center houses many programs and has 29,000 square feet dedicated to the automotive program.



The main automotive lab has 34 service bays. Other labs such as engine and transmission labs are adjacent to 4 dedicated automotive classrooms. 2 of the classrooms have in ground chassis dynamometers. Storage is always an issue for automotive facilities, so the facility has numerous areas to accommodate large items and provide for movement between the various rooms and labs.
