## From the Driver's Seat

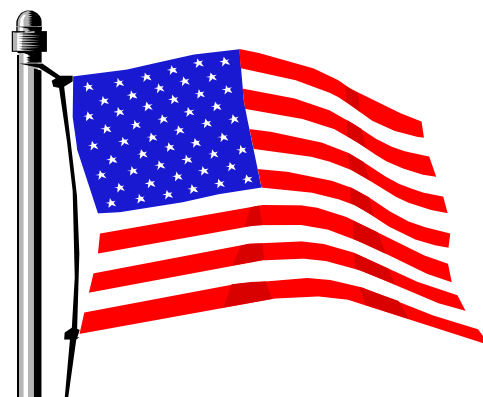


I hope your fall and new academic year have started well. Personally, fall is a busy and exciting time. A new group of students with fresh perspectives fill courses and reignite my passion
